To be eligible for an IYLP Secondary Education Scholarship the applicant must be an Indigenous young person who has the motivation and high potential to complete year 12 and be committed to succeeding. Scholarships are being offered for one year and student progress will be reviewed frequently. **Applicants must be eligible for AbStudy.**

A personal statement, written by you, is required to be submitted with this application. **This must be in your own handwriting and 250 words** (form provided with application). Tell us what your life goals are. For example, why you think you should be awarded a scholarship and how it will benefit you; tell us about your personal characteristics and leadership qualities; highlight examples from your life that you think are relevant to your application.

Ask a parent/guardian, teacher, or a friend to read your personal statement and help you with feedback.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Students selected for an IYLP secondary scholarship are required to attend an approved IYLP partner school. If you are selected and need to move from your current school, The Smith Family will help you make this change.

PLEASE NOTE:

Your application will **not** be considered if you do not submit the following information by **31st May 2024**:

- Student application form** (all sections must be completed, and the form must be signed by the applicant)
- Verification of enrolment at your current school** (on school letterhead and signed by the principal/authorised school representative)
- Your **most recent school semester report** (we require Semester 2, 2021 reports). **Applications will only be considered on condition your results are satisfactory.**
- Verification of Abstudy eligibility from Centrelink.** If you are not eligible for Abstudy, you must clearly state why you are educationally disadvantaged.
- Written references** from two referees on provided template (may be sent separately but must be received by 31st May 2024 and **must be on the template provided**)
- Personal statement**, written by you (in your own handwriting and 250 words)
- Parent/Guardian support & consent form** (all sections must be completed and signed by the parent/guardian)
- Confirmation from chosen Partner School that a place is available for the applicant starting in 2025** (please contact the school directly to confirm this. Please note, you do not need to provide this confirmation to us).
