🗆 Step 1	On your desktop, click the Window icon (#) in the bottom-left corner.
🗆 Step 2	Select Settings (().
🗆 Step 3	Select Accounts (\Re).
🗆 Step 4	On the Settings menu, Your Info option.
🗆 Step 5	Click Sign in with a Microsoft account instead.

Create a new email address

🗆 Step 6	A sign-in page will pop up. Click Create one!
🗆 Step 7	On the next page, click Get a new email address.
🗆 Step 8	 Enter your username into the "New email" form, before @outlook.com. This is the part that will identify you. If the name is already taken, you'll see an availability message.
🗆 Step 9	Once you've confirmed your username, click Next.
🗆 Step 10	 Now, you can create a password for your account. Then click Next. If you want to receive updates about Microsoft products and services, leave the tick box checked. If not, uncheck it. Clicking Next also means you agree to the Privacy Statement and Microsoft Services Agreement. The blue text links provide details.
🗆 Step 11	Enter your First name and Last name into the forms. Then click Next .
🗆 Step 12	In the Country/region list, select Australia.
🗆 Step 13	 Then you can select and enter your birthdate. Please make sure the year is correct as it affects account features.
🗆 Step 14	If all information is correct, click Next .

Link the account to your device

🗆 Step 15	Enter your Current Windows password into the form. The one you use to log in to your laptop and click Next .
🗆 Step 16	Choose additional sign-in options, you can use face recognition or your fingerprint. If you prefer, click Skip for now .
🗆 Step 17	Next is Create a PIN for easier access to your account. Click Next.
🗆 Step 18	 Enter your PIN. It's usually 4-6 digits long. Choose a PIN that is easy for you to remember but hard for others to guess. Avoid simple patterns like 0000 or using personal info.
🗆 Step 19	Confirm the PIN and click Finish .
🗆 Step 20	The final step is to keep your account details, including the username, password and PIN, somewhere private and secure. Losing the information could make it difficult to assess your account later.
