Full fee scholarships for eligible students

Ormond College is a fully catered residential college of 500 students at the University of Melbourne – a place to meet new friends, explore your interests and discover your potential.

With up to **\$1.3 million in financial assistance available** to eligible students we can help you make your university experience unforgettable.

Residential Scholarships

Students from our partners - Western Chances, Skyline Foundation, and The Smith Family - with high financial need could be eligible for a full fee or close to full fee remission scholarship (i.e. \$25,000+ pa) for the three years of their undergraduate degree:

- Apply to be a resident at Ormond College via the [website](#) before 6 Dec 2024.
- Apply for financial assistance with Ormond College before 6 Dec 2024 by downloading the [application form](#) and emailing to kexell@ormond.unimelb.edu.au.
- Advise you are a partner program student, so we can flag this on your application and waive the \$75 application fee.
- Complete an interview by 13 Dec 2024.
- Outcome known December or January depending on timing of application.

Non-Resident Scholarships

Partner program students with high financial need can access the Ormond College Non-Resident Program with full fee scholarship (\$8,260 pa in 2024):

- Apply to be a non-resident at Ormond by completing the non-resident [application form](#) by 6 Dec 2024
- Email kexell@ormond.unimelb.edu.au to advise you are a partner program student so we can flag this on the application.
- Complete an interview by 13 Dec 2024.
- Outcome known in January or February.

Additional scholarships for First Nations Students

Ormond College and the University of Melbourne both have generous scholarship programs available to [First Nations students](#).

Students attending the College may be eligible for ABSTUDY Residential Cost Option which would cover full fees to the College. The College also offers scholarships and bursaries to cover additional costs while at university.
