Supporting your child in preparing for life after school



This checklist can serve as a practical guide to help your child transition smoothly into adulthood and navigate responsibilities.



Get a Tax File Number (TFN)

- Apply for a Tax File Number (TFN) through the Australian Taxation Office (ATO) website or visit a local post office.
- Ensure they have the correct identification (e.g., passport, birth certificate) when applying.

Set up Superannuation

- Help them choose a superannuation fund that suits their needs (e.g., retail, industry, or selfmanaged super funds).
- Ensure they provide their TFN to their super fund to avoid additional taxes on their contributions.

Set up a MyGov account

- Guide them through creating a MyGov account, which can be linked to government services like the ATO, Medicare, and Centrelink.
- Ensure they verify their identity and link it to their email for notifications.

Get a Medicare Card

- Apply for a Medicare card if they don't already have one, ensuring they have access to healthcare services.
- Register online via the Services Australia website or in person.
- Ensure they understand how to use the Medicare system and when to visit a doctor.

Get Their Driver's License

- Ensure they know the requirements for obtaining a learner's permit and progressing to a full driver's license in your state or territory.
- Encourage them to book lessons with an accredited driving school if necessary.

Enrol to Vote

- Help them register to vote if they're over 18. This can be done online through the Australian Electoral Commission (AEC) website.
- Encourage them to stay informed about the voting process and upcoming elections.
- Discuss the importance of participating in elections and making informed decisions.

Find a Job

- Assist them in crafting a resume that highlights their skills, experience, and extracurricular activities.
- Help them explore opportunities for internships, apprenticeships, or volunteering to gain work experience.
