Setting up content filtering checklist






This checklist guides you through the steps to set up content filtering for your child's account.

● A panel or page ● Click the button ● Input the info

<input type="checkbox"/> Step 1	Log in to your account on the Microsoft Family Safety portal . (family.microsoft.com)
<input type="checkbox"/> Step 2	On the Your family page , click on the child's account you want to set restrictions for. 
<input type="checkbox"/> Step 3	Click the Content filters option on the left-hand side.

Step 4 Set up the function you want to use, under the **Web and search tab**:

<input type="checkbox"/>	To block a previously visited website	Find the Websites section , click the three dots next to the website, and select Block site . 
<input type="checkbox"/>	To block inappropriate websites and searches	Find the Filter settings section and turn the Filter inappropriate websites and searches toggle on. 
<input type="checkbox"/>	To only use allowed website	Find the Filter settings section , turn on the Only use allowed websites toggle . However, this function is very restrictive and not recommended. 
<input type="checkbox"/>	To block a specific site	Find the Filter settings section , under Blocked sites . Click the + icon to add the website you want to block.
