To be eligible for an IYLP Secondary Education Scholarship the applicant must be an Indigenous young person who has the motivation and high potential to complete year 12, and be committed to succeeding. Scholarships are being offered for one year and student progress will be reviewed frequently. **Applicants must be eligible for AbStudy.**

	Personal statement, written by you (in your own handwriting and 250 words)
	Parent/Guardian support & consent form (all sections must be completed and signed by the parent/guardian).
