all levels, significantly working in areas of disadvantage.

Her experiences have given her a passion for addressing injustice. ACRATH aims to
educate about, and address, the changing dimensions of human trafficking and
modern slavery; sham marriages, domestic servitude, labour trafficking, forced
marriage and trafficking for prostitution. Louise will share with us some of the most
beautiful and most painful experiences during her work and accompaniment to
women – children victims and survivors of trafficking or vulnerable people at risk of
being trafficked.
