"I had so much work to do it gave me a headache," he said. "But I also had the chance to take the children out. I decided they were more important and went for it.

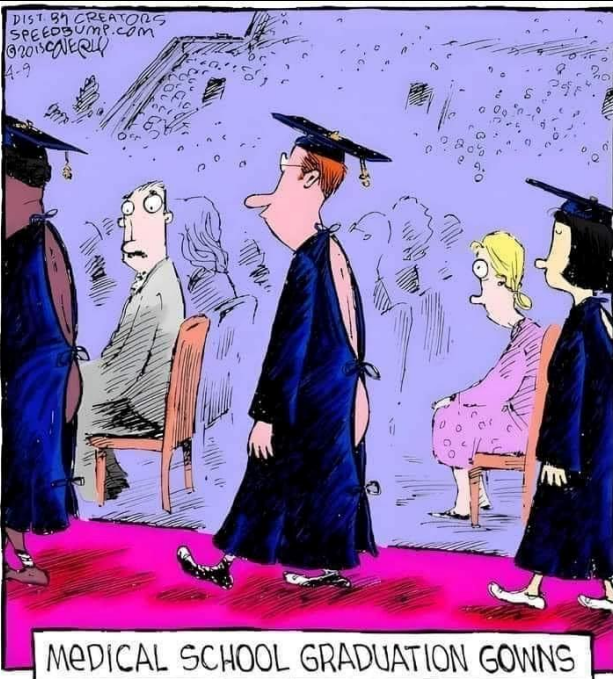
"When I got back home, the headache had gone. I got twice the work done in half the time."

Our paid work is important, but the work we do for love yields better dividends.

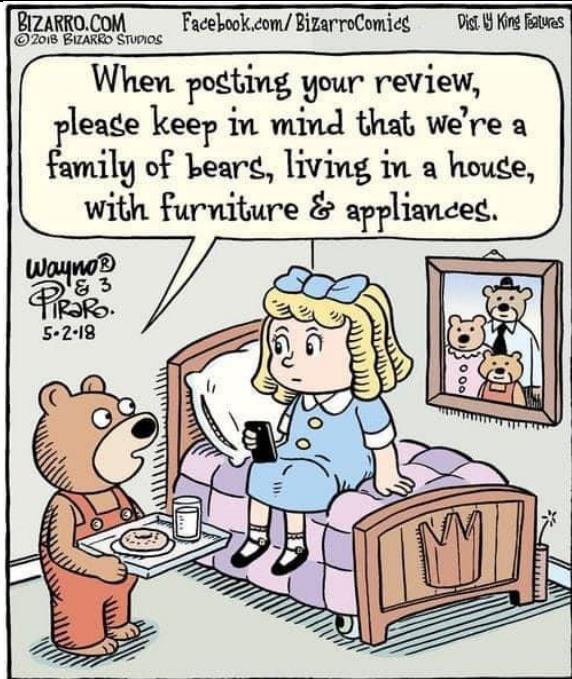
